#### FAQ:

Q: Can I stay with my child during the Saturday afternoon rehearsal?

A: Yes! Parents are welcome to stay in the Oberlin High School auditorium during the rehearsal block. We will also have other adults around to supervise young dancers.

Q: Can my child bring snacks?

A: Absolutely! Please feel free to bring snacks and water for the afternoon.

Q: What will my child do when he/she is not on stage?

A: Dancers will be kept in the auditorium from 1-3:30, then dismissed to their assigned dressing room to prepare for the showcase. Families should plan for their dancers to stay at Oberlin High School for the afternoon, and are encouraged to pack quiet activities (books, puzzles, games, etc) for when their dancers are not on stage.



## COSTUMES

Dancers are expected to adhere to the NCD dress code for this year's showcase, with a few exceptions. Dancers' hair should be up and secured away from their faces; light stage makeup (mascara, blush, lipstick) is recommended for all students. See below for dress code by genre/class.
